Year 1 Barnstaple Museum

Year 1 classes enjoyed a fantastic, although, slightly wet trips to Barnstaple Museum this week. Children enjoyed walking to and from the museum, dodging rain when we could, and pointing out lots of places they knew... including their own houses!

When we arrived at the museum, the children enjoyed speaking to Tammy, the Education Officer, where she talked about what history is, categorised it into the past/present/future and looked at artefacts from the past including shoes, cameras, toys, hats and an army uniform.

Children were then spilt into two groups and completed two different activities; the first involved children looking around the museum - the campervan, dinosaur fossils, moving trains and woolly mammoth were highlights for lots of them! The second activity involved handling lots of artefacts from the past, such as helmets, ration books, candle stick holders and photographs, before having a go at drawing them.
