Dear Parents and Carers,

You are probably aware that the Met Office has extended an amber heat warning from Sunday until Tuesday next week, as temperatures build this weekend and early next week.

There is clear government guidance on looking after children and those in early years settings during heatwaves, which includes the use of ventilation, keeping children hydrated, avoiding vigorous physical activity, encouraging children to wear loose, light coloured clothing and sunhats, to use sunscreen and providing them with plenty of water.

At Sticklepath, we will implement all these measures, and we ask parents/carers to make sure that children have hats and drinks with them and sunscreen has been administered.

We are also relaxing school uniform rules until Wednesday so children can dress in suitable loose, light-coloured clothing such as PE kits.

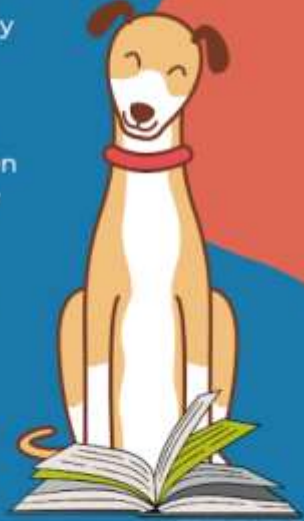
